

Getting started with BibleReader and *Lutheran Study Bible*



The following tips will help you get BibleReader and *Lutheran Study Bible* up and running. For more information on using the app with your specific device, be sure to check out the video tutorials and user guides available at www.olivetree.com/help.

1. Select and install the free BibleReader app.

On an iPhone, iPad, or iPod Touch, go to the App Store.

On an Android 1.6, 2.0 and newer, go to Android Market.

On other devices, go to <u>http://olivetree.com/m/</u>. You will be automatically redirected to the correct download page.

2. Open BibleReader. Tap on Library, then on Store.

3. Tap on **Browse** (at the bottom of the store window), then on **Study Bibles**. Scroll to **Lutheran Study Bible (Augsburg Fortress) with NRSV**.

4. Tap on **Lutheran Study Bible (Augsburg Fortress) with NRSV**. Set up an Olive Tree account and make your purchase.

Note: If you've been using BibleReader and already purchased the NRSV, the Notes are also available separately. (See the green arrow at the left.)

5. Tap on **Purchased** and scroll down to **Books in your Olive Tree account**. Pull up on this tab. Tap on **Lutheran Study Bible with NRSV**. Tap **Yes** to download and install.

Optional: The BibleReader app includes other resources, such as the American Standard Version, which can be installed at this time.

6. When you tap on Library or Open, **Lutheran Study Bible** and **New Revised Standard Version** will both appear in the list.

Tap on **My Stuff** (the suitcase icon at the top of the main window). Scroll and select **Learning Center** for in-app video tutorials on Getting Started and the Resource Guide.

Set up the Resource Guide

The Resource Guide in BibleReader gives you easy access to *Lutheran Study Bible* material and other resources.

1. In the split window of BibleReader (at the bottom or to the right on your device), tap **Open**. Tap on **Resource Guide** in the pop-up window. You will be asked whether you want to download the Resource Guide. Tap **Download**.

2. Tap on >> in the upper right corner of the Resource Guide, then choose **Resource Guide Settings**.



3. Tap on **Content**. Make sure **Show Content** and **Lutheran Study Bible** are turned **On** in the next window. (See example to the right.) Repeat this step in the Resource Guide Settings for Places, Charts, and Introductions.



4. In the Resource Guide Settings for **Bibles**, make sure **Show Bibles** and **New Revised Standard Version** are turned On.
