

Celebrate! A Rally Day Fair!

Invite your Sunday school participants and families to come to the fair! Set up the stations in separate classrooms or plan the whole event in a large gathering area.

Decorate the different stations to resemble fair booths. Twist crepe paper around tables and poles, hang colored rope lights, and make signs for each booth.



Booth 1: Ticket Booth

Purchase a roll of tickets at a party supply store. Hand these out as participants arrive. They'll turn in one ticket at each booth. (Participants do not need to visit the booths in order. Allow them to choose which they'll visit first, second, and so on. This will eliminate crowding at the booths.)



Booth 2: The Midway

Set up a ring toss game, a fishpond, and/or space for partner activities such as a three-legged race, water balloon toss, etc. Have a few people nearby to do face painting and make balloon animals using non-latex balloons.

Booth 3: Concessions Stand

Rent an old-fashioned popcorn maker, or pop popcorn in a popper or microwave. Divide it and place in small paper lunch bags, one for each participant.





Booth 4: Craft Fair

Invite the children, youth, and adults in your congregation to bring items they have made, such as quilts, drawings and paintings, needlework, woodcarvings, etc. to display at this booth. Or have available construction paper, crayons, markers, craft sticks, glue, glitter glue, yarn, and other craft items for participants to make their own creations to display.

Booth 5: The Grandstand

This is a place for your congregation members to showcase their God-given talents! Create a sign-up sheet with space for adults, youth, and kids to sign up in five-minute increments. Hang it in a prominent place of your church and ask people to sign up to sing, dance, tell jokes, act, play an instrument, or anything else. They'll come and perform on the Grandstand during the time for which they signed up!
